Warbirds Over Wanaka 2024

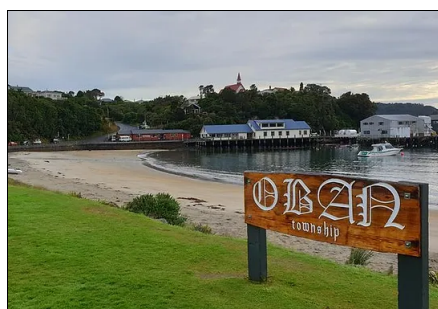

Top of the South Island

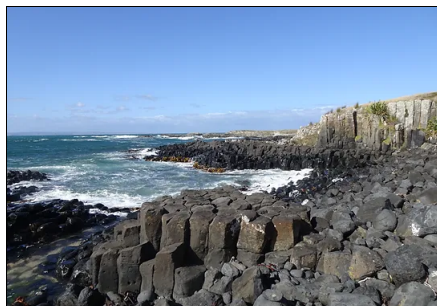

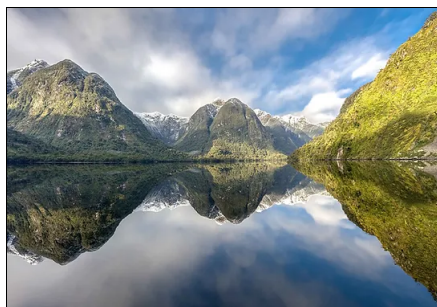


Visit the stunning Chatham Islands where we will enjoy it's history, culture, arts and crafts, wildlife, amazing scenery and of course great food and hospitality...
